CHART NAME: NATURALIZATION BENEFITS


WHAT IT DISPLAYS: The below chart provides data on the Applications for Naturalization (Form N-400) received by USCIS for the month of January 2013.

WHAT IT SHOWS: Naturalization receipts in January 2013 increased by 1 percent when compared to January 2012, while approvals/oath increased by 13 percent and denials increased 54 percent.
