WHAT IT DISPLAYS: The below chart provides data on applications and petitions received by USCIS for immigration benefits in June 2013. This chart excludes all data associated with the citizenship related applications.

WHAT IT SHOWS: Immigration application receipts increased by 38 percent compared to the number received in June 2012. June 2013 approvals increased by 20 percent, denials increased by 16 percent, and pending increased by 42% compared to June 2012.
