DISCUSSION: The immigrant visa petition was initially approved by the Director of the Texas Service Center on September 17, 2001. The director subsequently revoked her approval of the petition on March 24, 2003. The matter is now before the Administrative Appeals Office on appeal. In a letter dated September 1, 2003, the petitioner states that the beneficiary's daughter has become a United States citizen and will file an immigrant visa petition on the beneficiary's behalf. The petitioner requests that this appeal be withdrawn.
