This chart does not include motions, certifications, or non-merit appeal dispositions (for example, rejections, summary dismissals, and withdrawals). AAO decisions to remand are indicated because, for certain categories, the AAO may not sustain an appeal and grant a benefit outright until the field office completes certain administrative tasks.

Note: The reported forms may vary from year to year as the volume of cases change throughout the 5-year span. The forms listed are the most common case types that AAO receives.
