
Upon the basis of respondent's admissions, I have determined that the respondent is subject to removal on the charge(s) in the Notice to Appear.

Mexican wrestler remains in county jail

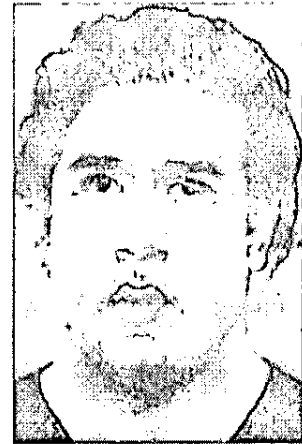

In the wrestling ring, Hector Garza's trademark move is the spin "plancha," which found him springing off the ropes, twisting in mid-air and pummeling his hapless opponents.

Right now, the only springing the Mexican superstar hopes to do is out of a Harris County Jail, where he is being held after his arrest on charges of possession of a controlled substance.

The 35-year-old wrestler, whose real name is Hector Solano Segura, was en route to Orlando, Fla., for a taping of the Fox Sports Network show *TNA Impact!* when he was detained Monday afternoon by immigration agents at Bush Intercontinental Airport. The show had to be rescripted because of Segura's arrest.

According to Mexican newspaper *El Norte*, Segura was in possession of anabolic steroids Primobolan and Deca-Durabolin, which are commonly used to increase muscle mass. He did not have a prescription for the drugs with him.

"TNA Entertainment does not condone the use of any illegal substance by an independent contractor or employee of the company," said Brad Bernstein, public relations manager. "Hector (Segura) and his attorney are anxious to proceed with the case and prove Hector's innocence. We look forward to his return."

Segura's brother Humberto, who is also a wrestler, told *El Norte* that a prescription for the drugs was being sent immediately from Dr. Jose Luis Banda Robles in Mexico. The prescriptions was being used by Segura to regenerate injuries and fortify muscle tissue, his brother said.

"I've never heard of any policies or testing by TNA," said Mike Johnson, writer for PWInsider.com, a comprehensive wrestling Web site. "This is really their first case of dealing with something like this publicly."

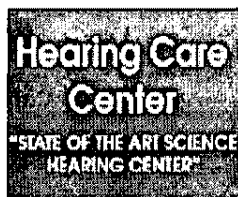
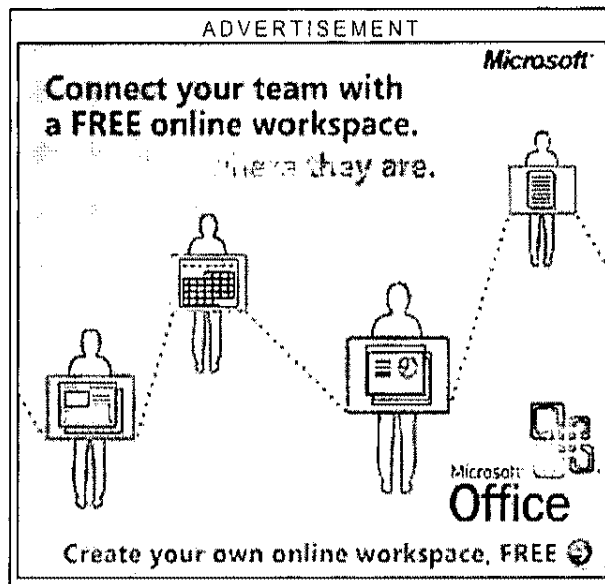
The 5-foot-11-inch, 209-pound Segura is seen as a star on the rise in wrestling circles and is known for his entertaining and stylized wrestling matches. He has wrestled professionally for more than 12 years and is a headline attraction in Mexico.

Segura worked for Ted Turner's now-defunct World Championship Wrestling before joining TNA last year as the leader of Team Mexico.

Segura was featured as a main-event contender during the New Year's Eve edition of *TNA Impact!* and won an X-Gauntlet Cup during a three-hour pay-per-view event in November.

With Segura's popularity, TNA has tapped into the Spanish-language market, where "lucha libre" (Mexican-style wrestling) has always had a fervent fanbase.

"There have been a lot of deaths of very young wrestlers in the last decade. If it was any other sport, every newscast in the United States would be on it big time," Johnson said. "Wrestling, by definition of the type of entertainment it is, mostly falls under the radar by the media, which creates a completely different breed of animal for the wrestling business overall."

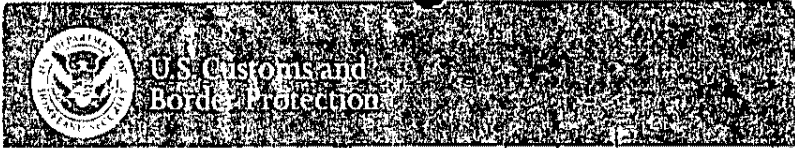

Mexican wrestler arrested on drug possession charges

■ 'Hector Garza' is in Harris County jail; brother says he has prescription for the steroids

A Mexican wrestler seen as a rising star in his sport remains in a Harris County jail on drug possession charges.

Hector Solano Segura, whose stage name is **Hector Garza**, was en route to Orlando, Fla., for a taping of the Fox Sports Network show *TNA Impact* when he was detained Monday by immigration agents at Bush Intercontinental Airport. He was charged with possession of a controlled substance.

The show was rescripted because of Segura's arrest.

According to Mexican newspaper *El Norte*, Segura, 35, had anabolic steroids Primobolan and Deca-Durabolin, commonly used to increase muscle mass. He did not have a prescription for the drugs with him.

"TNA Entertainment does not condone the use of any illegal substance by an independent contractor or employee of the company," said **Brad Bernstein**, public relations manager. "Hector and his attorney are anxious to proceed with the case and prove Hector's innocence. We look forward to his return."

Segura's brother Humberto, who is also a wrestler, told *El Norte* that a prescription for the drugs was being sent immediately from Dr. **Jose Luis**

Banda Robles in Mexico. Segura was using the drugs to regenerate injuries and fortify muscle tissue, his brother said.

"I've never heard of any policies or testing by TNA," said **Mike Johnson**, a writer for *PWInsider.com*, a comprehensive wrestling Web site. "This is really their first case of dealing with something like this publicly."

The 5-foot-11-inch, 209-pound Segura has wrestled

professionally for more than 12 years. His trademark move is the spin *plancha*, in which he springs off the ropes, twists in midair and pummels his opponents.

Segura worked for Ted Turner's now-defunct World Championship Wrestling before joining TNA last year as the leader of Team Mexico.

"There have been a lot of deaths of very young wrestlers in the last decade. If it was any other sport, every newscast in the United States would be on it big time," Johnson said.

"Wrestling, by definition of the type of entertainment it is, mostly falls under the radar by the media, which creates a completely different breed of animal for the wrestling business overall."

Singer survives lost mattress

"Everything happened in such a whirlwind,"

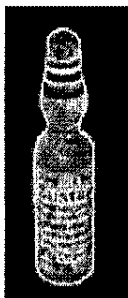

Anavar - oxandrolone

The compound with the generic name Oxandrolone SPA by S.p.A. Milano Company (Societa Prodotti Antibiotica) from Italy is the only original anabolic steroid available in Europe which contains the substance Oxandrolone. There are 30 tablets in one box with one push-through strip of 30 tablets. Oxandrolone is a weak steroid with only a slight androgenic component. It has been shown that Oxandrolone, when taken in reasonable dosages, rarely has any side effects. This is appreciated since Oxandrolone was developed mostly for women and children. Oxandrolone is one of the few steroids which does not cause an early stunting of growth in children since it does not prematurely close the epiphysial growth plates. For this reason Oxandrolone is mostly used in children to stimulate growth and in women to prevent osteoporosis. Oxandrolone causes very light virilization symptoms, if at all. This characteristic makes Oxandrolone a favored remedy for female athletes since, at a daily dose of 10-15 mg, masculinizing symptoms are observed only rarely.

Bodybuilders and powerlifters, in particular, like Oxandrolone for three reasons. First, Oxandrolone causes a strong strength gain by stimulating the phosphocreatine synthesis in the muscle cell without depositing liquid (water) in the joints and the muscles. Powerlifters and weightlifters who do not want to end up in a higher weight class take advantage of this since it allows them to get stronger without gaining body weight at the same time. The combination of Oxandrolone and 20 - 30 mg Holotestin daily has proven to be very effective since the muscles also look harder. Similarly good results can be achieved by a simultaneous intake of Oxandrolone and 120-140 mcg Clenbuterol per day. Although Oxandrolone itself does not cause a noticeable muscle growth it can clearly improve the muscle-developing effect of many steroids. Deca Durabolin, Dianabol (D-bol), and the various testosterone compounds, in particular, combine well with Oxandrolone to achieve a "mass buildup" because the strength gain caused by the intake of these highly tissue-developing and liquid-retaining substances results in an additional muscle mass. A stack of 200 mg Deca Durabolin/week, 500 mg Testoviron Depot (e.g. Testoviron Ethanate 250)/week, and 25 mg

Oxandrolone/day leads to a good gain in strength and mass in most athletes. Deca Durabolin has a distinct anabolic effect and stimulates the synthesis of protein; Oxandrolone improves the strength by a higher phosphocreatine synthesis; and Testoviron Depot increases the aggressiveness for the workout and accelerates regeneration.

The second reason why Oxandrolone is so popular is that this compound does not aromatize in any dosage. As already mentioned, a certain part of the testosterone present in the body is converted into estrogen. This aromatization process, depending on the predisposition, can vary distinctly from the athlete to another. Oxandrolone is one of the few steroids which cannot aromatize to estrogen. This characteristic has various advantages for the athlete. With Oxandrolone the muscle system does not get the typical watery appearance as with many steroids, thus making it very interesting during the preparation for a competition. In this phase it is especially important to keep the estrogen level as low as possible since estrogen programs the body to store water even if the diet is calorie-reduced. In combination with a diet, Oxandrolone helps to make the muscles hard and ripped. Although Oxandrolone itself does not break down fat, it plays an indirect role in this process because the substance often suppresses the athlete's appetite. Oxandrolone can also cause some bloating which in several athletes results in nausea and vomiting when the tablets are taken with meals. The package insert of the Italian Oxandrolone notes its effect on the activity of the gastrointestinal tract. Some athletes thus report continued diarrhea. Although these symptoms are not very pleasant they still help the athlete break down fat and become harder. Those who work out for a competition or are interested in gaining quality muscles should combine Oxandrolone with steroids such as Winstrol, Parabolan, Masteron, Primobolan Depot, and Testosterone propionate. A stack of 50 mg Winstrol every two days, 50 mg Testosterone propionate every two days, and 25 mg Oxandrolone every day has proven effective. Another advantage of Oxandrolone's nonaromatization is that athletes who suffer from high blood pressure or develop gynecomastia of the thymus glands when taking stronger androgenic steroids will not have these side effects with this compound. The Oxandrolone/Deca Durabolin stack is a welcome alternative for this group of athletes or for athletes showing signs of poor health during mass buildup with testosterone, Dianabol (D-bol), or Anadrol. Athletes over forty should predominantly use Oxandrolone.

The third reason which speaks well for an intake of Oxandrolone is that even in a very high dosage this

compound does not influence the body's own testosterone production. To make this clear: Oxandrolone does not suppress the body's own hormone production. The reason is that it does not have a negative feedback mechanism on the hypothalamohypophysial testicular axis, meaning that during the intake of Oxandrolone, unlike during the intake of most anabolic steroids, the testes signal the hypothalamus not to reduce or to stop the release of GnRH (gonadotropin releasing hormone) and LHRH (luteinizing hormone releasing hormone). This special feature of Oxandrolone can be explained by the fact that the substance is not converted into.

For this reason Oxandrolone combines very well with Andriol, since Andriol does not aromatize in a dosage of up to 240 mg daily and has only slight influence on the hormone production. The daily intake of 280 mg Andriol and 25 mg Oxandrolone results in a good gain in strength and, in steroid novices, also in muscle mass without excessive water retention and without significant influence on testosterone production. As for the dosage of Oxandrolone, 8-12 tablets in men and 5-6 tablets in women seems to bring the best results. The rule of thumb to take 0.125mg/pound of body weight daily has proven successful in clinical tests. The tablets are normally taken two to three times daily after meals thus assuring an optimal absorption of the substance. Those who get the already discussed gastrointestinal pain when taking Oxandrolone are better off taking the tablets one to two hours after a meal or switching to another compound.

Since Oxandrolone is only slightly toxic and usually shows few side effects it is used by several athletes over a prolonged period of time. However Oxandrolone should not be taken for several consecutive months, since, as with almost all oral steroids it is 17-alpha alkylated and thus liver toxic. Oxandrolone is an all purpose remedy which, depending on the athlete's goal, is very versatile. Women who react sensitively to the intake of anabolic steroids achieve good results when combining Oxandrolone/Primobolan Tabs and/or Clenbuterol, without suffering from the usual virilization symptoms. Women, however should not take more than 6 tablets daily. Otherwise, androgenic-caused side effects such as acne, deep voice, clitoral hypertrophy or increased growth of body hair can occur.

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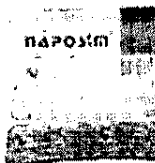

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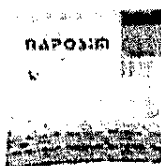

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FAQ

Q: How long do steroids stay detectable in your system?

A: This, of course, depends on the actual substance (amount and type) ; person using them. Steroids can remain detectable in a persons system from 1 week to over a year after use. For the most popular substances li nandrolone (deca, testosterona), one year is the usual time that they co actually be detected. For injectable testosterone, between 3-6 months is commonly sufficient. Luckily, for steroid users, the cost of a steroid test expensive (heard its \$280) and hardly ever done. If you are being tested "drugs" 99% of the time a steroid test is not done. Random tests for coll will test for them though (the cost is probably why they are random). Pe usually worry more than they should though. Even though a drug "can" l detectable, a lot of times they aren't.

Q: I bought 10ml bottle, how can I store it?

Q: What are the best ways and what are best steroids for women

A: Women athletes certainly do need to take a different approach to ster than males do. There are only a limited number of the drugs listed in thi a woman would even want to consider. Among those are Primobolans, P Nolvadex, Nandrolones, Anavar, Winstrol, and synthetic Growth Hormon important to note that even on the lowest dosages of any of these steroi women can start to experience virilizing effects. This is because any amc steroid introduced into the woman's endocrine system is a serious jolt. A steroids are synthetic derivatives of male hormones and can cause serio

reactions in some women. The most prudent approach to administering steroids to the female involves the use of low dosages of very low androgenic items. Women obviously do not have to worry about the Gonadotrophic suppression that men do nor do they usually encounter much of a problem with the hepatotoxicity of anabolic steroids. This is because they most often use low dosages of very clean items. Since the most androgenic items tend to be toxic to the liver, by avoiding these items women also avoid the liver strain that most men undergo. Women can however benefit from the use of estrogen antagonists. Many women favor the use of Nolvadex and/or Proviron when they use anabolic steroids to attain muscularity. Anabolic steroids have been extremely effective for women athletes who use them to obtain size, strength and endurance. Side effects women suffer from using anabolic steroids tend to be minimal. It is prudent to use caution at all times. One of the safer ways that I have seen women use anabolic steroids is to stack two low androgenic items for a period of less than six weeks and then take several weeks off of the drugs before coming back on another four or five week cycle and then taking a good two months off of the drugs. With this pattern, women can watch for adverse reactions which tend to occur in proportion to the duration of use by the female. The use of Growth Hormone by women has proven to be extremely effective in some cases. Growth Hormone is not an androgenic drug, it does not result in any virilizing effects for women. Growth Hormone greatly increases muscularity primarily by reducing body fat stores in the woman while leaving the lean muscle mass unaltered.

Q: How much of the weight that is usually gained on a steroid cycle is actually solid muscle?

A: The majority of weight gained on a steroid cycle is from retention of cellular and extra cellular fluid. This is what many lifters will call "water bloat". This water weight gain is beneficial up to a certain point. It provides extra space for the muscles and increases their ability to contract by simply giving them more area to work in. The average weight gain on a steroid cycle ranges anywhere from five to twenty pounds. Let's say a lifter has gone on a two month steroid cycle and gained a total body weight of twelve pounds. By monitoring body fat percentage through body composition analysis, an athlete can keep an idea as to how much of what they gained is body fat. Although anabolic steroids can increase the ability to mobilize and use fat stores, many athletes find that they gain more weight and increase in body fat while on a bulking cycle. This is simply because they are consuming an excess amount of calories on an effective bulking program. This is actually a benefit, not a hindrance, at this time. Let's say our subject who gained twelve pounds determined through body composition analysis that he had put on eight pounds of body fat. This leaves an eight pound increase in lean body weight. That eight pounds, it is very likely that only two pounds are skeletal muscle. It is known that for every one pound of skeletal muscle you put on, the body retains with it three pounds of supportive cellular and extra cellular fluid. Still, a gain of two pounds of skeletal muscle mass is a substantial gain.

Q: What accounts for the incredible pump I get while I am using anabolic steroids?

A: The "steroid pump" does have an actual physiological explanation. It is primarily due to the fact that there is more blood available in the body during a steroid cycle. One of the effects of anabolic steroid use is an increased production of RBC's (red blood cells). That increases blood volume and greatly improves the oxygen carrying ability of blood. This increases the efficiency and endurance of skeletal muscle cells. A 200 pound lifter could carry an extra liter of blood during this time. This increased blood volume partially explains why some athletes are "pumped" all the time while they are on a steroid cycle. It also explains why

incredible pump you get while working out at this time.

Q: I have pondered the question whether or not to use steroids for years. I have finally made up my mind that I am going to try them. I was just wondering what kind of results I should expect?

A: This is really a difficult question to answer. Results vary greatly from individual to the next. In general, steroid users find that their first cycle is the most dramatic in terms of the gains that they make. Some users claim to gain solid thirty pounds on their first cycle while others notice little if any gain. Obviously, the athlete that has weight trained for a number of years, and who continues to train intensely during the cycle and who eats a high calorie, high protein diet, stands to put on a lot more muscle than the athletes who are not as disciplined enough to follow through with the whole program. It has been substantiated that a steroid user taking moderate dosages of Nandrolone Decanoate and Dianabol can gain twice as much muscle mass in a two month cycle than they could in an entire year of effective training. It is felt that an individual can gain a maximum of 4 pounds of muscle per year for every 100 pounds of body weight that they possess. This would translate to a 200 pound man having a maximum potential to gain 8 pounds of muscle per year, which would be an enormous gain. The first time steroid user can gain as much as 16 pounds per 100 pounds of body weight in a single ten week cycle. This is 2 times the first time steroid user could gain 16 pounds of muscle in just 2 months. The maximum potential without drugs would be 8 pounds in an entire year. It is not hard to see that the steroid gains are substantially higher.

This does not mean that if a person can gain 16 pounds of muscle in two months on a steroid cycle that they could gain 96 pounds of muscle if the athlete stayed on steroids for twelve months straight. Certain inhibiting factors prevent this. Evidence suggests that the maximum gains of a steroid cycle are reached by the eighth week. It is rare for the first time steroid user who eats right and trains hard not to gain at least four or five pounds of solid muscle.

Q: Do most professional bodybuilders use steroids?

A: Yes they do. I would estimate that 100% of all professional bodybuilders use steroids and I would go as far to say that 90% of the athletes that compete at the national amateur level use anabolic steroids. Obviously, few of these athletes are admitting to steroid use, especially at this point in time. Anabolic steroid use has never been more of an antisocial behavior than it is right now, and the situation is getting worse all the time. Professional bodybuilders have to stand out and prove that they denounce the use of the very drugs that helped them achieve their current status or they face serious consequences. The point of being a professional bodybuilder to begin with is that they have reached a level of notoriety that is synonymous with marketability.

Through seminars, posing exhibitions and endorsements, the professional bodybuilder turns all of his hard work into financial success. All of that is in serious jeopardy if that athlete has been branded with the stigma of using illegal and banned substances to reach their position.

Thus, you will see nauseating hypocrisy in athletes at that level, not only in bodybuilding but in many sports where the athletes are idolized by the general public. Many professional bodybuilders have sincere intentions and they condemn the use of anabolic steroids in athletics, as they recognize the enormous abuse potential for these drugs when placed in the hands of ignorant individuals. I would criticize their actions further if I could honestly say that I would not do the same thing placed in their position.

Q: My doctor informed me that using veterinarian steroids is very dangerous. He said that they are not fit for human consumption.

you think?

A: Veterinarian steroids do not have to meet the exact same sanitary specifications that human pharmaceuticals do; however, they are generally under sanitary conditions. Legitimate veterinarian steroids are certainly a better choice than using any form of a counterfeit. I have never heard from an athlete that felt they were harmed by the use of a veterinarian steroid. Interestingly enough, some of the most modern anabolic steroids are for veterinarians. However, there are numerous new veterinarian anabolic steroid preparations developed every year. A number of these preparations look to be remarkably anabolic with minimal androgenic qualities. These agents should optimize mass increases while minimizing androgenic side effects. Australia seems to be producing most of these new vet drugs.

Q: Is it possible to use Anadrol in a pre-contest cycle without retaining water?

A: The pre-contest use of Anadrol is untraditional yet several bodybuilders have done it with outstanding results. Few, if any steroids, deliver the type and strength gains seen with Anadrol. Anadrol gives the muscles bulk and hardness that would be extremely desirable in a bodybuilding show. The problem with Anadrol almost always causes water retention and it aromatizes quite easily, resulting in high estrogen levels. Some bodybuilders have successfully overcome this estrogen and water retention problem by using Nolvadex at 10 to 20 mg per day in a stack with 50 mg of Anadrol right up to the day before the bodybuilding contest. Very often, a prescription diuretic such as Dyazide, Lasix, or Aldactone is used for three or four days before the bodybuilding contest to eliminate subcutaneous water retention if it did exist. Usually, it is a good idea to supplement with potassium salts such as Slow-K when using prescription diuretics. Some bodybuilders have been able to control the water retention with over-the-counter diuretics. Other effective methods have involved taking the Anadrol right up until the day before the contest and then switching to Halotestin for the last seven days. This has worked well for some who find that the Anadrol takes a good two or three days to get out of the system and then they find they still have the muscle mass but don't have the water retention problem. Halotestin maintains muscle mass without the water retention.

Q: I am currently cycling the steroids Deca Durabolin at 200 mg per day and Sustanon at 250 mg every ten days. I am making great gains on a simple cycle. Unfortunately I am suffering from some acne on my back that seems to be aggravated by the use of these steroids. I have a prescription for Tetracycline which I have used in the past to control acne. Would there be any problem with taking the Tetracycline while I was on these steroids?

A: Tetracycline and anabolic steroids do not go well together. Tetracycline is a broad spectrum antibiotic that has many purposes. It works primarily by inhibiting protein synthesis. Since Tetracycline does exhibit this anti-anabolic effect, it is working in the opposite direction of the anabolic steroids. Anabolic steroids increase protein synthesis and can encourage bacteria growth which often aggravates acne. Tetracycline may inhibit the functions of the anabolic steroids and the anabolic steroids may inhibit the effects of the Tetracycline. Rather than examine which drug would come out on top, it seems the easiest solution is to not use Tetracycline while taking anabolic steroids. Other ways that athletes have been able to control acne that is caused by the use of steroids include: using benzoyl peroxide more frequently, using prescription soaps, using tanning beds, by using Accutane, and the last course might involve using Accutane, a prescription acne medication.

Q: I have gotten in the habit of taking small amounts of Primobol or Deca off and on between cycles. For example, during an off cycle of four months, I usually take a single 50 mg shot of Deca every week and occasionally take 50 mg Primobolan Depot. Is this a bad practice?

A: It is common for athletes to use a small amount of a mild anabolic steroid between cycles, but it is not a good idea. Non-stop use can inhibit the body's natural testosterone production and other endocrine system functions from returning to normal. Although such low dosages would likely not exhibit toxicity nor promote any significant side effects, they would also not yield the way of positive effects. Many bodybuilders continue to use small doses of steroids between cycles because of their insecurities with letting go of steroids completely. Many steroid users develop an attitude that if they are not taking steroids they are simply not making any gains, and to justify even training will use small amounts of steroids between their cycles. If I were to make a recommendation on the use of low dosages of mild steroids between cycles, I would not encourage it. The off cycle period is a time to train naturally and allow the body fully recover from the steroid use and I believe you can only fully recover if all steroids are eliminated from the system.

Q: What is the correct way to open glass ampules?

A: Glass ampules are a real pain. The proper way to open them is to score around the narrowest part of their neck. To score these glass ampules, you should use a metal knife with small teeth. Occasionally, these are provided with a scoring ampule and these knives work best. If these knives are not provided, it occasionally works to use a fingernail file, grapefruit knife, or a type of kitchen knife with very small teeth. This knife should be rotated around the narrow neck in a sawing motion. After a white line or 'score' is clearly evident on the neck, the ampule is ready to be cracked open. Before cracking the ampule, it should be placed inside a clean paper towel or a thin clean cotton towel. You should firmly grasp the lower portion of the ampule, the other hand should grasp the very top. A quick snapping motion should cleanly remove the top of the ampule. A needle can then be inserted and the liquid drawn out. Do not try to crack open an ampule without scoring it or by using your fingers directly on the glass ampule. Occasionally the glass ampule can shatter and this glass can cause a serious cut.

Q: I have heard a couple of rumors that seem to indicate that the calculated use of oil based testosterone will go undetected by urine tests. Are some athletes using testosterone for contest preparation in drug tested events?

A: The rumors you are hearing are repercussions of a research project in which a half of dozen males were given various dosages of oil based testosterone (I believe it was Cypionate) for a period of six weeks and tested to see if they would pass a urinalysis. All six subjects displayed an acceptable testosterone to epitestosterone level which would not have resulted in a positive test. The subjects were using a dose of 300 mg per week, which is quite a bit of testosterone. More and more bodybuilders are using testosterone for contest preparation. They must learn to manage the water retention that can accompany steroid use; this is often done with the use of unbanned diuretics. The use of injected testosterone amongst college football players is reportedly very high. You can guess that the NFL has a high percentage of athletes using testosterone. One athlete informed me that he used a high dosage of the oral testosterone Andriol (testosterone undecanoate) at a drug tested bodybuilding contest in California and passed with an acceptable testosterone to epitestosterone ratio. This bodybuilder stated that he used eight capsules of Andriol per day for

approximately four weeks prior to the contest and only stopped using the days before the contest. His ratio was 4.5 to 1 (a positive ratio is 6 to 1 in most cases). Low doses of testosterone are the prototype undetectable. There are rumors of exotic European steroids which cannot be detected; but the actual use of these products is very low. The actual use of testosterone, on the other hand, has always been popular.

Q: I am using a type of injectable oil based steroid. My problem is I cannot get all the tiny little bubbles out of the oil after I pull it into the syringe. I have heard that if an air bubble gets in the syringe and injected, it can kill you. What should I do to make sure I am injecting safely?

A: First of all, it would likely take a full three ccs of air injected right into the muscle to cause a fatality. Small air bubbles injected intramuscularly in an oil solution pose a hazard, yet it is a good practice to eliminate them anyway. Small bubbles that appear in an oil solution after it is drawn into the syringe will rise to the top of the syringe if held needle-side-up. This may take as long as 10 minutes with some persistent tapping on the side of the case. After the bubbles have risen to the top of the solution, the stopper can be slightly pressed which will expel the air from the syringe.

Q: What is the difference between a cc, a ml, an I.U., a mg and a mcg?

A: A cc (cubic centimeter) is equal to a ml (milliliter). They measure volume. For example if a vial contains 10 ml of liquid, that is the same as 10 ccs. A mg (milligram) measures the dose of a drug, A mg is equal to 1/1000 of a gram. A mcg (microgram) is equal to 1/1000 of a milligram. An IU (International Unit) is used to measure the dose of a preparation.

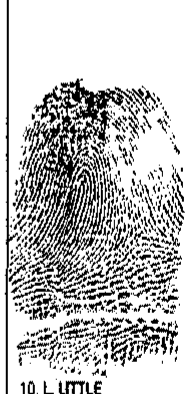
