The above named alien, a motion picture actor, applic for a reentry permit in person at the New York office of this Service on Sept. 13, 1954. The reentry permit was issued at New York under the authority of 0.1. 223.12 I. The application was referred to this offic for review and filing because the alien resides in this district.

The file reveals no reason why the reentry permit should not have been issued, however, the file does not reveal any details concerning the subject's selective service status during World War II.

Mr. Montalban was born in Mexico in 1920. He entered the U. S. permanently in 1939. On Feb. 6, 1942 he departed from the U. S. with a reentry permit. The permit was subsequently extended until May 27, 1943. There is no record in the file of the aliens re-entry but he did surrender his alien registration card and departed permanently at Burbank airport on Nov. 15, 1944. He reentered the U. S. with a 4(c) visa in February, 1946 and has resided here since that date with the exception of a short trip in 1951.

It is suggested that the alien be questioned the his return to the U.S. and his draft status during World War II be explained.

INFORMATION CONCERNING PERMITS TO REENTER

A permit to reenter has no elect under the immigration laws except to show the person to whom issued is returning from a temporary visit abroad and telieve him of the necessity of securing a visa front at American Consul before returning to the United States. It does not telieve him from meeting the other requirements of the immigration laws. Persons who have been convicted of or admit having committed a felony or other crime or misdemeanor involving moral turpitude either before or after entering the United States, other criminal, immoral, insane, mentally or physically defective aliens, those afflicted with loathsome or contagious diseases, and others found to be inadmissible under the immigration laws are subject to exclusion if attempting to reenter, notwithstanding they may be in possession of permits to reenter.

EFFECT OF ABSENCE FROM UNITED STATES UPON NATURALIZATION ELIGIBILITY

A permit to reenter does not relieve the person to whom issued from meeting the requirements of the naturalization laws. Motwithstanding the possession of a reentry permit, absence from the United States by an applicant for naturalization for a continuous period of 1 year or more during the period for which continuous residence in the United States is required for admission to citivenship will break the continuity of such residence, except where, prior thereto, the Attorney General has approved an absence in the employment of, or under contract with, the United States Government or an American institution of research recognized as such by the Attorney General, or in the employment of an American firm or corporation engaged in whole or part in the development of foreign trade and commerce of the United States or a subsidiary thereof, make than 50 percent of whose stock is owned by an American firm or corporation, or in the employment of a public international organization of which the United States is a member by treaty or statute and by which the alien was not employed until after being lawfully admitted for permanent residence. In order to quality for such approval the applicant must have been physically present and residing in the United States, after being lawfully admitted for permanent residence, for an uninterrupted period of at least 1 year. The granting of such approval does not exempt the applicant from the requirement that he be physically present in the United States for at least one-half of the period of residence required for naturalization except in the case of those persons who are employed by, or under contract with, the Government of the United States; those persons who are engaged solely by a religious denomination having a bona fide organization within the United States as a missionary, brother, nun or sister. Such approval should be applied for on Form N-470. "Application to Preserva Residence for Naturalization Service.

Aliens who are absent in connection with or for the purpose of performing the ministerial or priestly functions of a religious denomination baving a bona fide organization in the United States, or who are engaged by such a denomination or an interdenuminational mission organization baving a bona fide organization within the United States, as a missionary, brother, non, or sisten, are also eligible to make such application. Such aliens may acquire the required 1 year of uninterrupted physical presence after the absence.

EXTENSIONS

The validity of a permit may, on good cause shown, be extended for a period or periods not exceeding 1 year from the original expiration date. Application for extension should be made between 30 and 60 days prior to the expiration date shown on this permit.

The application must contain (a) the name of the applicant, and his address in the United States; (b) when, where, and by what means he departed from the United States; (c) port of landing and date of arrival abroad; (d) countries visited in the order visited; (e) reason for requesting extension and period for which desired; and (f) applicant's address abroad; and must be accompanied by the permit.


The application must be sworn to. If executed in the United States the application may be sworn to before an officer of the Immigration and Naturalization Service, without payment of notarial fee; or before a notary public or other officer authorized to administer oaths for general purposes; and in such cases, the official seal or certificate of authority to administer oaths must be affixed. If executed outside the United States, the application must be sworn to before a Consular Officer of the United States.

The application must be submitted to the officer in charge of the district in which the holder resides in the United States by the person to whom the permit was issued and must be accompanied by a fee of \$10. Remittances by persons outside the United States should be by international money order, drawn on Washington, D. C., or foreign exchange on a bank in the United States. All remittances should be made payable to the Immigration and Naturalization Service, Department of Justice. If extension is refused, the fee will be refunded. 

nigration laws except to show that the person to A Reentry permit has no effect under the m issued is returning from a temporary visit abroad and relieve him of the necessity of securing a visa from an American Consul before returning to the United States. It does not relieve him from meeting the other requirements of the immigration laws. Persons who have been convicted of or admit having cammifted a feloxy or other crime or misdemeanor involving maral turpitude either before or after entering the United States, other eximinals, immoral, infanc, mentally or physically defective cliens, those efficied with locissome or contagious diseases, and cities found to be inadmissible inder the immigration laws are subject to exclusion if attempting to reenter, notwithstanding they may be in passession of reentry pedmits.

EFFECT OF ABSENCE FROM UNITED STATES UPON NATURALIZATION ELIGIBILITY

This permit does not relieve the person to whom issued from meeting the requirements of the naturalization laws. Notwithstanding the possession of a reentry permit, absence from the United States by an applicant for naturalization for a continuous period of one year or more during the period for which continuous residence in the United States is required for admission to citizenship will break the continuity of such residence, except where, prior thereto, the Attorney General has approved an absence in the employment of, or under contract with, the United States Government or an American institution of research recognized as such by the Attorney General, or in the employment of an American firm or corporation engaged in whole or in part in the development of foreign trade and commerce of the United States or a subsidiary thereof. Such approval should be applied for on Form N-470, "Application for Benefits of Sec. 307 (b) or 308, Nationality Act of 1940," available at any immigration of naturalization effice. Aliens absent in the capacity of a regularly ordained clergyman or nun are also eligible to make such application.

PENALTY FOR FALSE STATEMENTS

"Whoever knowingly makes under oath any false statement in any application, affidavit, or other document required by the immigration laws or regulations prescribed thereunder, shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined not more than \$10,000 or imprisoned for not more than five years, or both." (Sec. 22, Act of May 26, 1924, 43 Stat. 153, Sec. 220.)

EXTENSIONS

The validity of a permit may, on good cause shown, be extended for a period or periods not exceeding 6 months each.

Application for extension should be made between 30 and 60 days prior to the expiration date shown on this permit.


The application must contain (a) the name of the applicant, and his address in the United States; (b) when, where, and by what means he departed from the United States; (r) port of landing and date of arrival abroad; (d) countries visited in the order visited; (e) reason for requesting extension and period for which desired; and (f) applicant's foreign address to which permit is to be returned.

The application must be sworn to before a consular officer of the United States.

The application must be sent to the District Director of Immigration and Naturalization who issued the permit by the person to whom the permit. was issued, accompanied by a fee of three dollars (\$3). Remittance should be by international money order, drawn on Washington, D. C., or foreign exchange on a bank in the United States, payable to the Commissioner of Immigration and Naturalization, Washington, D. C. If extension is refused, the fee will be refunded. The permit, if extended, will be returned to the foreign address given in the application.

Where the validity of the permit or extension thereto has expired, the alien must obtain an immigration visa from an American Consul before

embarking for the United States.






